Pursuant to articles 13, c. 2, sub-para c, 14, c. 2, sub-para d, 15 and following, of the General Regulations on Data Protection - Regulation (UE) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and Council dated 27 April 2016 relating to the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and the free movement of such data (hereafter "**GDPR**"), and our attention in furnishing you information related to the processing of personal data supplied by you for aims of the relationship with B.T.V. Right to address the personal data protection agency (article 77)	Notwithstanding all other administrative or juridical recourse, if you consider that the processing of concern to you violates the regulations on matters of protection of personal data, you have the right to lodge a complaint to a supervisory body, particularly in the member state in which your normally reside, work or of the place where the presumed violation occurred.	

The exercising of the above-mentioned rights is subordinate to the limits, the rules and procedures set out in the GDPR and which the Interested party must know and implement. Furthermore, along with the provisions of article 12, para 3, the data controller will supply the interested party with the information relating to the action taken without unjustified delay and, in any case, not later than one month from receipt of the said request. If necessary that period may be extended to two months, depending on the complexity and number of requests. The Data Controller will inform the interested party of such a delay, along with the reasons for it, within one month of receipt of the request.

The exercising of the rights is, in principle, free; the data controller reserves the right to ask a contribution towards the costs in the event on manifestly unfounded or excessive requests (even repetitive).

Whenever the data controller has reasonable doubts regarding the identity of the natural person lodging this application, he may ask for further information which might be necessary for confirming the identity of the interested party.

I am informed that the data contained in this form is used exclusively for providing feedback to the application and will be preserved for 5 years, in order to guarantee suitable evidence of the proceedings should the matter be subject to administrative or judicial recourse.
